• Preferred Certifications:

- Internationally recognized TVET/Assessment qualifications (e.g., City & Guilds, Pearson, IHK)
- Any additional certification in Quality Assurance or Educational Partnerships will be an added advantage.

Experience:

- Minimum 7 years of post-qualification professional experience, with at least:
 - 3-5 years in managing or facilitating international certifications or qualifications within the TVET, education, or skills development sector.
 - Experience working with international awarding bodies, regulatory authorities, or accreditation councils.
 - o Demonstrated experience in international collaboration, partnership building, or MoU execution with certifying agencies.

• Desirable Experience:

- Familiarity with **recognition of prior learning (RPL)**, qualification frameworks (e.g., NSQF/TVET frameworks), and **quality assurance** mechanisms.
